- Maintain an index page and update the same regularly. Write chapter number and chapter name, date and page number in index page.
- Make a title page before starting new chapter.
- Start every new chapter on a new page. Write the name of the unit on top of the page.
- Write the date on the right-hand margin.
- Leave one line before moving onto the next question.
- Always highlight/ underline and write in capital letters the following headings in the notebook.
- In case of any mistake, don't scribble or cut, use ink correction tape.
- Leave one page after completion of each chapter for correction work.
- Avoid tearing pages or scribbling on the notebook.
- Do not scribble, write other subjects/notes/draw drawings at the back of the notebook.
- Draw all diagrams/illustrations neatly and label them.
- Use a ruler to draw lines for margins/tables/ flowcharts ,on completion of one Q/Ans. Etc.

- Teachers need to do very thorough and accurate checking.
- Read each and every word carefully while correcting.
- The corrections should be so thorough that even commas and full stops should not be ignored.
- Correct only with red pen

- Corrections must be written by students 5 times.
